## Hindustan Scouts and Guides Camp Second Day :- Camp Report

The day began with the prayer song and Hoisting the Scouts and Guides Flag. After that the following activities were conducted with different groups of students.

List of Activities:-

1. **Scout Prayer and flag song:** The students were taught Scout and guide pledge and were also given Scout and Guide rules to be followed by our young scouts.
2. **Scarf folding :-** In this Trainer distributed the scarfs and gave the instructions on how to fold the scarf of scouts and guide. They, then, asked the students to put woggle on it .
3. **Salute & Claps :-** Students learned the scout salute on command & different kinds of scout claps like Wa wa clap, Rocket clap, Welcome clap, Thank you clap, Bahubali clap and special clap etc.
4. **Bridge Crossing:** Students were asked to walk on the rope with a support of another rope tied above them and they have to cross the way.
5. **Pass a message:** The students were made to stand in a circle and were given a message to pass to the next child standing to them.
6. **Fast and throw ball:** In this activity students were asked to go and pick the ball kept at different distance.
7. **Observing:** The students were asked to feel the objects kept in the bag and identify the objects without looking at them. The students were try excited and tried to identify the objects kept.
8. **Hand signals:** Hand signals are an essential communication tool in scout camps, helping scouts convey messages silently. Signals like go back, come here, stop etc. were taught to our student scouts.
9. **Promise:** The Scout Promise is a fundamental part of scouting, outlining the values and principles that scouts commit to uphold. The core elements of the promise is around the duties related to self, others and country.

10. **CID game:** In this game one student will find out the mistake of other children who are not doing the activity properly.
11. **Arjun:** The trainer instructs the students and the same actions are followed by the students. The activity is intended to improve listening skills and acting accordingly.
12. **Ball motion and clap:** The activity is intended to improve the coordination and teamwork of the students. According to the ball motion, the students were expected to clap. This was intended to enhance their attention span and hence improve reaction time.
13. **Lotus Making:-** Students were asked to stand accordingly next to their groups and followed by the instructions given by the scout leader, they have beautifully arranged themselves in the form of Lotus.
14. **Smelling Activity:-** In this activity, students were asked to smell the each pouch hanging on a rope and identify the smell of that particular things. Students were actively and smartly identified the smell of the spices and answered.

Overall, Day 2 of the Hindustan Scouts and Guides Camp was a successful event, fostering personal growth and teamwork among students.
